



Hospice of the Valleys Skydive Experience Terms and Conditions

Booking Terms and Conditions

(In this section 'you/your' refers to the jumper)

1. By signing up you agree to raise the minimum amount of sponsorship £395.00
2. A £50.00 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of booking
3. Sponsorship must be raised by 3 weeks prior to jump date together with the sufficient evidence of this.
4. Where insufficient sponsorship has been raised, it is your responsibility to pay the difference to the amount of £395.00. You will NOT be able to jump if this amount has not been raised.
5. Should the weather be unsuitable for jumping on the specified date, another date will be arranged.
6. **Payment;** Your **deposit** must be paid directly to **Skydive Swansea** at the time of your booking. **Sponsorship** must be paid to **Hospice of the Valleys**, who will pay the necessary jump fees in accordance to the terms in this section.
7. A fee of £40 will be applied if any participant changes the date within 3 weeks notice of the jump date.
8. Once you have signed up you automatically become bound by the terms and conditions by Hospice of the Valleys and Skydive Swansea. Please read carefully the terms and conditions issued by Skydive Swansea during the booking process.
9. All bookings once received by the Hospice of the Valleys are then processed through Skydive Swansea with the relevant information shared with these parties to confirm booking and activity. Your details will not be passed to anyone else and you can view the Hospice of the Valleys Privacy Statement on the Hospice website www.hospiceofthevalleys.org.uk

Medical Restrictions

(In this section 'you/your' refers to the jumper)

For a tandem skydive you must be at least 16 years old. The weight restrictions are 15 stone for male and 13 stone for female with your weight in proportion to your height including clothing and trainers.

There are TWO DIFFERENT TANDEM MEDICAL forms. EVERYONE doing a tandem skydive has to fill out ONE of these medical forms.

Please read carefully the TANDEM STUDENT PARACHUTIST MEDICAL INFORMATION AND DECLARATION (form 115A) to see which one you need to fill out.

If you have not suffered in the past or do not currently suffer from any of the conditions listed on the TANDEM STUDENT PARACHUTIST MEDICAL INFORMATION AND DECLARATION (form 115A) you may fill in this form yourself without going to the doctor.

If you have or you have had in the past or do currently suffer from any of the conditions listed you must get your doctor to sign & stamp the OTHER form called the – STUDENT TANDEM PARACHUTIST REQUEST FOR MEDICAL ADVICE (FORM 115B)

A LETTER FROM YOUR DOCTOR IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. THE DOCTOR MUST SIGN & STAMP THE STUDENT TANDEM PARACHUTIST REQUEST FOR MEDICAL ADVICE FORM IF REQUIRED

Other Important Information

(In this section 'you/your' refers to the jumper)

If you are over the age of 60, or rely upon walking aids for your mobility then you will be required to attend the parachute centre for a pre assessment before the booking can be accepted by Skydive Swansea. It is Skydive Swansea's policy not to allow anyone who uses or relies on a wheelchair to undertake a tandem skydive.

Minimum age to jump is 16 years. If you are 16 or 17 years of age you must have a parent/guardian's signature on the BPA membership agreement/Parental consent form and on the Tandem Student Parachutist Medical Information and Declaration Form – these forms are available to download on the Skydive Swansea website; <http://www.skydiveswansea.co.uk/documents/>

Insurance

(In this section 'you/your' refers to the jumper)

On payment to the parachute centre of the fee for the training and the jump, you are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy up to £5 million for liability to Third Parties. Please note that this does not cover you or your dependants for personal injury including death. You are therefore strongly recommended to take out your own insurance cover for personal accident benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Parachuting is an adventure sport and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed. I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the sport and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless Hospice of the Valleys and Skydive Swansea against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).

By completing my booking, I am confirming that I have read all the above sections marked Booking Terms and Conditions, Medical Restrictions, Insurance, and Important Notice, and understand and agree to be bound to those terms and conditions and to comply fully with.
