



Hospice of the Valleys Bungee Jump – Terms and Conditions

Sponsorship option if applicable to your entry (You /Your = the participant)

For this event you pledge to raise a minimum of £200 (excluding gift aid or registration fees where applicable) in sponsorship money for Hospice of the Valleys. Eighty percent (80%) of the sponsorship must be received by the Hospice 2 weeks prior to the event, with the remaining amount within one month of the event. All funds raised through the event must be payable to Hospice of the Valleys in £ sterling. The objective is to enjoy the event whilst raising as much sponsorship as possible.

All participants: (You /Your = the participant)

You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. In making the decision to take part you are satisfied that this activity is suitable for you as an individual. Hospice of the Valleys cannot be held accountable for aggravation to illness or injury sustained due to participation in this event. You are recommended to seek advice from your medical practitioner prior to taking part in this event, and make provisions to ensure your safe participation.

You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions and documentation issued by the event organisers and associates and to comply with these.

The minimum age for the Bungee Jump is 14 years and has measurement restrictions.

All participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian consent and registration form signed by the responsible adult.

You are fully responsible for your actions whilst attending the event. This includes the event centre and during the event itself. Hospice of the Valleys does not accept responsibility for your actions nor the consequences of such actions.

You accept that Hospice of the Valleys will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses, which may arise from your participation in this event.

Event registration fees cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

Hospice of the Valleys reserves the right to cancel any event, due to extreme weather conditions or Force Majeure. In such an event, each participant's entry will be automatically moved to the rescheduled event. If a participant cannot make this event, they will be given the opportunity to transfer their place to another participant after consultation with the Hospice and through the appropriate method. No refunds will be issued.

If the event is cancel by the organiser, all participants will automatically be moved to the new re-arranged date. No refunds will be issued.
